Notice of road and lane closures on the A452 southbound

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and Murphy & Sons known as LM. In your area, we are working near the A452, A45 and M42, which surround the site of the future HS2 Interchange Station.

We're preparing for our future construction works

To help us build a new highways bridge over the A446, we need to install a temporary barrier to protect our workforce and the travelling public prior to construction. To install the barrier safely, we need to undertake a number of lane and road closures in your area.

We'll be starting work on 29 July

We'll be carrying out daytime single lane closures from Monday 29 July to Friday 2 August, and an overnight road closure on Thursday 22 August, along the A452 southbound (see maps on pages 2 & 3). A signed diversion route will be in place taking drivers via M6 Junction 4, from Northway Island, and southbound along the A446.

We have planned daytime lane closures

We will be carrying out temporary single lane closures on:

Monday 29 July to Friday 2 August

9.30am to 3.30pm

A452 southbound from Northway Island to Stonebridge Island

We have a planned overnight road closure

We will be carrying out a temporary overnight road closure on:

Thursday 22 August

8pm to 6am

A452 southbound from Northway Island to where the A446 merges with the A452

Duration of work

From Monday 29 July to Thursday 22 August 2019.

Daytime working hours will be 9.30am to 3.30pm, Monday to Friday.

Overnight working hours will be 8pm to 6am.

Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after those times.

What to expect

Lane and road closures on the A452 southbound from Northway Island to Stonebridge Island.

A temporary barrier will be installed to protect our workforce and the public.

What we will do

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Ensure clear diversion signage is in place.

Leave the area in a tidy state when works are complete.



Temporary daytime lane closure along the A452 southbound, from Northway Island to Stonebridge Island, from Monday 29 July to Friday 2 August:




