What is an Appraisal?

- A review carried out *by local people* of all aspects of their community:
 - its assets and strengths
 - its deficiencies, problems and needs
 - and future challenges

Why do an Appraisal?

- It is the first step in enabling local people to shape the future of our village and community
- It identifies the issues that people care about and action they want to see taken
- It provides evidence of community support and local need to help in attracting funding for future local action
- It helps influence decision-makers

and more reasons.....

- Doing it strengthens our community, engaging more people in the life of the village
- It is a crucial step towards producing an action plan for our community- the Parish Plan
- Government is encouraging the “handing down” of powers and assets to local communities that can demonstrate they know what they want.

Tried and tested?

- Yes – a lot of experience across the country, including nearby villages
- Measurable benefits to these communities
- Better relationships with their local councils and other public service providers
- We can use their best practice
- ***Meriden needs to catch up!***

An Appraisal – the stages

➤ Stage 1: *What are the facts and issues?*

- What are the relevant facts about Meriden?
- What do people like about Meriden and what are the issues of concern?
 - Household questionnaire
 - Workshops with various sections of the community (young people, older people etc)
 - Meetings with business, community, public service and other organisations (for example young farmers group, Rotary, churches, the school, the surgery etc)

An Appraisal – the stages

- **Stage 2: *What should be our objectives and priorities?***
 - What should Meriden be like in the future?
 - What should our priorities be for improving life in Meriden? – Short, medium and long term?
- **Stage 3: *A Meriden Parish Plan***
 - A detailed Action Plan
 - Winning support and commitment
 - A basis for influencing decision-makers
 - A basis to ensure **OUR** needs are recognised and built into Local Area Agreements

Who will undertake the work?

- Ourselves – the local community
- As many people as possible:
 - those who are willing to distribute and collect questionnaires
 - those who are willing to engage their organisation, their friends and neighbours
 - those with particular specialist skills and knowledge
