- *You are registered as a local government elector for the parish;*
- *You have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the parish during the whole of the 12 months before the day of co-option;*
- *Your main or only place of work during the 12 months prior to the day of co-option has been in the parish; or*
- *You have lived in the parish or within three miles of it during the whole of the 12 months before the day of co-option.*
